COVID-19 CONFERENCE ARRANGEMENTS

We are excited - and extremely fortunate - to be able to host the OCRA 2021 Annual Conference. The following items will differ from past OCRA conferences:

OCRA Seminar/Session Rooms

Beginning at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, April 9, the general sessions/seminars for the 2021 Annual Conference will be held in the Admiral A/B ballroom. Due to social distancing recommendations, seating will be arranged for one person per 6-foot table. There will be additional chairs placed at the back of the ballroom, not at a table, to accommodate overflow attendance and observers for sessions. If you are comfortable with the distance between yourself and fellow attendees, you may remove your facial coverings during the sessions while seated.

OCRA Luncheon
